Guest Presenter Leigh Nesbitt:

On an extremely well supported Monday evening, we were treated to some words of wisdom and practical caution from IT & Cyber Security Specialist Leigh Nesbitt. Leigh's presentation chaired by Mary McIntyre was packed with examples and practical advice on how to reduce the risk of heavy financial losses from identity theft and criminal scams.

First be **aware and alert if dealing with uninvited contact** whether by phone, email, text, social media or in person at your door, by someone purporting to be from your Bank, Medicare, Tax office or Government department or any business you may deal with.....recognise that this may be a scam.

These organisation are using sophisticated software to build their knowledge and profile you. That's why they sound credible, appear to know lots about you and "always express urgency that you don't hang up" while they fix the problem.

In this situation it was recommended that you do not share any information take their details, hang up and contact your bank or provider immediately.

Golden rules:

- Never give anyone access to your computer or reveal personal details.
- Keep mobile devices and computers secure with regular software updates
- Choose passwords carefully
- Beware requests for payments
- Be careful sharing personal details, birthdays etc on social media
- Avoid hotspots when doing business
- Take care shopping online, use trusted sites only.
- Be vigilant with Bitcoin or other virtual currencies.

....and you also might consider, putting a lock on your mailbox, or consider a PO Box for bills and shred bills before throwing them in the recycle bin.


