RORP Container Loading Notice

Please note the change of Container loading venue on Saturday 3rd September

We are off and running for D9820's next Container, Cape Town, South Africa.

Saturday: September 03, 2022 is the Main Loading Day.

Other Loading Dates:

- Once the Container arrives on September 01, all the large aluminium uprights will be loaded and then the smaller steel uprights loaded inside the Aluminium ones....Local RORP Team...approx 2 hours effort...Note: Some pre-loading of trailers on August 31, ready for September 01.
- Saturday, September 03, will be the major load out morning when the awkward/heavy shaped items are loaded, and the loadout task completed...D9820 RORP Team plus enthused folk....approx 4 hours effort
- Then the following 3 or 4 days can be admin and the final touches etc.....Local RORP Teams plus enthused folk...approx 2 hours effort.

BBQ Lunch and Drinks Supplied on Sept 03.

On September 03, here should be two RORP Teams, one at the Storage and Trailer Loading Facility (4 Jillian Way, Mount Martha)and the other team at New Peninsula Baptist Church, 370 Craigie Road Mount Martha (note: new venue) to load the container.....each team with about six able bodied

Plus two drivers with their vehicles: (Good for folk on Light Duties)

- One vehicle with Electric Brakes fitted pulling the RORP Trailer
- The other pulling Greg's tandem trailer.

Both locations have Coffee/Drinks/Toilets available.....and are about 3km apart on country roads.

The aim will be to load at a minimum: 12 playgrounds.

Other Critical Dates:

September 01, 2022:...Container being delivered to New Peninsula Baptist Church, 370 Craigie Road Mount Martha

September 08, 2022:...Container being pickup from loading location ... > Melbourne Docks.

September 11, 2022:...Ship Sailing from Melbourne Docks > Cape Town.

October 17, 2022......Ship arrives in Cape Town.

Saturday, September 03 is the main day and Wayne will speak at the Club meeting on Monday 29th August to confirm all arrangements



UPDATE ON THE FUNDRAISING FOR DREKETI SCHOOL (Laucala District School) QAMEA ISLAND, FUI





Dreketi Village - January 2017

More excellent news with fundraising for the new school. On Wednesday 17th, Helene and I did a Zoom presentation to the Rotary Club of Rosebud. President and long time friend Philip Hedley gave us a call the following day and their Board approved a donation of \$5,000 AUD. Yay!

Approx one month ago, the Rotary Club of Northbridge in Sydney contacted Fiji Rotary to find out about good projects. We submitted the school info immediately and our project was awarded \$3,000 AUD.

The Rotary Club of Leongatha was informed of our project and also contributed \$2,500 AUD.

In the July report we had 12 Rotary clubs donating plus Como Laucala Resort and private donations for a total of \$122,170 AUD. The total has now reached \$132,670 AUD (FJD \$ 202,000). Our target is \$150,000 AUD (FJD \$225,000). Chasing the last FJD \$20,000

I am also very pleased to mention that two cluster groups are looking at the Dreketi project. One is through Cecilia Estoppey from the Mitchell River Bairnsdale cluster and the second through PDG Janet McMahon from the eClub Latitude 38 and cluster cubs.

On another front we have school board members Jona Nawaqavou and a good friend of Taveuni and Qamea Mr Ioane Naivalurva. They are currently working with the Education Minister and Fiji Government to prepare a start date.

For this report, there are 16 Rotary Clubs that have donated and those clubs are spread across 5 Rotary districts (9810,9820, 9920, 9930 and 9685)
