A Good News Story from Roger Skipsey

I was talking to John Mackie (Mornington Care) about sponsoring a hole for the Golf Day again. He said he would gladly do so but would not be playing this year.

During this conversation John told me about the plight of Mr John Crossin aged 69 who had only recently been struck down with Lewy Body Dementia and was forced into care. He explained how the disease strikes the body first and then the mind, particularly irrational anxiety that causes tremors. John Crossin is now in care and that his family where struggling to pay the \$52 /day cost over and above his pension. A fundraising event was planned for 17 November.

John Crossin owned Beaches Restaurant and gave dozens of musicians their first break, he also participated in 16 Variety Club Bashes raising over \$300,000 for Variety. He is much loved and respected in Mornington .

I suggested to John that perhaps RCMM could help via Dick Smith's Compassionate Grants. I investigated further. John talked to Merv at the Golf Day (even though he didn't play) and I decided to apply for the maximum project value of \$15,000 as John Mackie was able to donate \$7,500 from the fundraiser proceeds to qualify for the dollar for dollar grant.


The grant was approved and now John Crossin's care will be funded till mid Oct 2020 thanks to RCMM and Dick Smiths Compassionate Grants.
